**Subject: Terms and Conditions/Code & Conduct for all affiliated State/City Twenty20 cricket Associations and its officials Affiliated with: Indian Twenty20™ Cricket Federation®&© ITCFINDIA™**

Dear Sir,

The management of Indian Twenty20 Cricket Federation ITCF-India has decided to introduce terms & conditions/ Code & conduct for the affiliated units & its officials/office bearers of ITCF India i.e. as under

- a. All State/City Units are bound to take approval from ITCF-INDIA for organizing the National/ Zonal/ State Levels tournaments in their States/ City. All states/ city units have to mention their code number & zone allotted by ITCF clearly in their official documents. All State/City Units are bound to take every year renewal of their affiliation & appointment letter from ITCF-INDIA.
- b. All State/City Units are bound to take approval from ITCF-INDIA while send their State/City/ District/Zonal teams for private cricket tournaments i.e. non approved from ITCF If any state/city Twenty20 cricket associations official found involved in above said matter then the concern unit is facing ban as per rules and regulations of ITCF-INDIA
- c. All the necessary documents/certificates are to be issued by ITCF-INDIA for State/National/International level tournaments.
- d. All the players/officials are necessary to register with ITCF and fill its registration form & paid annul membership to ITCF India without this no one consider for ITCF India.
- e. For all Indian domestic players at first they should be the registered player of their respective distt./zone/state/city Twenty 20 cricket association affiliated with Indian Twenty 20 cricket federation ITCF INDIA. After this process all the concern players are eligible for playing cricket under ITCF.
- f. All State/City Units are bound to take approval from ITCF-INDIA for press statements / press Columns in newspapers /magazines/ websites and interviews and statements about ITCF-INDIA and its officials.
- g. All State / City Units are bound to send their State Teams in National level T20 tournaments organized by ITCF-INDIA. If any unit fail to participate in 2 consecutive nationals then the concern unit will face ban as per ITCF regulations. If any state/city Twenty20 cricket associations official found involved in anti federation activates. Federation will dismiss the concern official from the units and federation. Also appoint new officials for concern unit as per rules and regulations of ITCF-INDIA & bound to obey the rules and regulations and another terms and conditions set by ITCF.
- h. All the registered players/officials of ITCF bound to take written permission from federation for any other sports related activities.
- i. **Trade Mark:** All the Affiliated State/City Units should send their official letterpad copy, 'Logo', Kit Colour & Official dress for other functionaries to ITCF-INDIA for approval so as to differentiate from one and another team. All affiliated units can not used ITCF India logo as this is Federation's legal property (TM)
- j. All the Affiliated State/City Units are to sign a central contract with ITCF-INDIA on behalf of their affiliated units this central contract duly signed by president and secretary on behalf of their units. i.e. Sponsorship for International matches in India and Abroad host by ITCF- India on TV rights,


Logo-matters and other financial matters for all the Affiliated State/City Units that all unit of ITCF are bound to give all the sponsorship/financial assistance/ donation other financial deals on behalf of their units to ITCF India also give the 40% of their sponsorship to federation while host the ITCF T20 national event or international T20 events in their concern jurisdiction.

- k. **Life Ban/Other Punishments** : The players and officials who registers with ITCF, India or any affiliated State Unit, if involves in match fixing or any type of betting, or anti federations activities or taking drugs and other serious misconduct/misbehaviour/legal offence in or out of field, he will face Life Ban or other punishment as per rules and regulations.
- l. **No Objection Certificate (NOC)**: If any registered player with ITCF-INDIA or any affiliated State/City Unit wants to change his state, will have to take prior permission from Federation and NOC from his concerning State Unit duly signed by President and the Secretary of the State Unit. All the affiliated units hire two professional players for National Level tournament organized by ITCF-INDIA and also take prior permission from Federation. The criteria of registered players Junior/Senior from state/city unit are by birth in state/city and he should be residing there from last 2 yrs. The necessary documents should be produced by the institution where he is working or studying. In junior levels the criteria of age proof is every junior player registered with Sate/City unit should produce the proof duly signed by his parents i.e Affidavit, Birth Certificates from corporations or schools duly attested by gusted officer & also certified by state/city units secretary/president. If any player is found misrepresenting these facts ban for life or other punishment can be imposed on him and the units which for which he may be representing can be canalled
- m. If any foreign players wants to play cricket in India under ITCF, he must have the citizenship of India and holder of Indian passport also complete the guidelines/rules and regulations of BHART SARKAR regarding citizenship also complete the rules of federation.
- n. The same rules are applicable on all officials i.e. district./zonal/state/city Twenty20 cricket associations affiliated with ITCF India.
- o. **Legal Authority**: As a member of the International Twenty 20 Cricket Federation (ITCF-USA) & Asian Twenty20 Cricket Federation (ATCF) Indian Twenty20 Cricket Federation (ITCF INDIA) has the authority to select players, umpires and officials to participate in international events and exercises total control over them. Without its recognition, no competitive cricket involving ITCF INDIA-contracted Indian players can be host within or outside the country.
- p. **Permission**: All the registered players/officials of ITCF & its affiliated units are bound to take written permission from federation for any other sports related activities. This circular is valid from today i.e. 1<sup>st</sup> day of January, 2010 and will be implemented with immediate effect.

All the State/City/District/Zonal/Tehsils/Clubs Twenty20 cricket associations of ITCF India™ are advised to bring the contents of this circular to the notice of all members working under their administrative control and act accordingly. The receipt of this circular may kindly is acknowledged.
